□ 2. Language Evaluation

If you have not satisfied the language requirement through coursework, but believe you have gained the equivalent language proficiency through experience in a German-speaking environment in the U.S. or abroad:

- 1. Email Professor Nikolaus Euba, the German Language Program Coordinator in UC Berkeley's Department of German, to request an appointment for a language proficiency assessment. Prof. Euba's email address is <u>euba@berkeley.edu</u>. You should do this weeks before the application deadline to make sure the language evaluation can be completed in time. If you don't do well enough on the language assessment in all four skills listening, speaking, reading, and writing you might not be eligible for this program at this time and you may need to choose another program, or continue studying the language until you meet the minimum requirement. Some students are fluent speakers but have less knowledge of grammar.
- 2. Print a copy of the <u>Language Evaluation Form</u> and bring it to your exam. The results of your evaluation will be recorded on the Language Evaluation Form.
- 3. Upload a copy of the Language Evaluation Form with your EAP application.
