

UCEAP Preliminary Academic Planning Form

The Preliminary Academic Planning Form is required at the time of application for the purposes of *selection* and *placement* in an UCEAP program. A final Academic Planning Form with major adviser signature(s) will be required prior to departure for your EAP program. The list below is not your final course selection for UCEAP.

- List the titles of courses you are interested in taking on EAP.
 - √ 8-10 courses for year-long programs
 - √ 4-5 courses for semester programs
 - √ 2-3 courses for summer programs (or number required by program)

Convert all EAP courses into **semester** units. Courses on the UCEAP website and in the MyEAP Public Course Catalog are referenced in UC quarter units; these will be converted to semester units on your Berkeley transcript. **The # of quarter units / 1.5 = # of semester units** (round to one decimal). Example: 5 quarter units / 1.5 = 3.3 semester units.
