1. Coursework

- Coursework Taken at Berkeley:** I have completed / will complete Spanish 4, Spanish 20, or Spanish 22 (or higher) at Berkeley prior to departure for the program.
- Coursework Taken at Another institution:** I have completed / will complete the *equivalent* of Spanish 4, Spanish 20, or Spanish 22 (or higher) at another institution prior to departure for the program.

2. Exam Scores

- Advanced Placement (AP) Spanish Language Exam score of 5.
- SAT II Spanish Subject Test score of 550 or higher.
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Higher Level Spanish Language Exam score of 7.
