Language Prerequisite: The minimum language prerequisite is one year of university-level French by the end of the last semester prior to departure. This program does not have a minimum language CPA, however, a passing grade is required for all French courses taken at the college level being used to meet the language requirement. It is also possible to meet the requirement if you have taken 4 years of high school French, or if you scored a 3 or higher on the Advanced Placement French Language exam.
