



2019 Airola-Murveit Mobility Scholarship, Domestic

Berkeley Study Abroad is seeking applicants for the 2019 Airola-Murveit Mobility Scholarship. Four scholarships of **\$7,500** will be awarded to qualified applicants of the [Berkeley Global Internships: Boston, Massachusetts – Research and Entrepreneurship](#) program in summer 2019.

Eligibility:

- Applying to the Berkeley Global Internships program in Boston, Massachusetts
- Be receiving an AB 540 nonresident tuition exemption in the 2018-2019 academic year
- Have financial need demonstrated by a 2018-2019 California Dream Act application
- Be a current UC Berkeley student (Expected Graduation Date of Summer 2019 or later)
- Have remaining financial need after all other eligible gift aid and scholarships have been calculated towards the Global Internships Boston cost of attendance.
- Work authorization is not required.

- Submit a scholarship application no later than Wednesday, February 20, 2019
- Scholarship announcements will be made on Friday, February 22, 2019
- Awardees must accept their scholarship by Tuesday, February 26, 2019
- Awardees must submit a complete Global Internships Boston application no later than Friday, March 1, 2019 and meet all minimum program eligibility
- Per program policy, all applicants are charged a \$400 non-refundable program deposit on CalCentral
