



2019 Airola-Murveit Mobility Scholarship, International

Berkeley Study Abroad is seeking applicants for a special donor scholarship that supports high achieving, high financial need students that have not previously had the opportunity to travel outside of North America. Four scholarships of **\$5,000** will be awarded to qualified applicants of [Berkeley Global Internships programs in Dublin, Israel, London, Madrid, Mumbai, Prague, Paris, and Sydney](#).

Minimum Eligibility:

- Participating in Berkeley Global Internships program in Dublin, Israel, London, Madrid, Mumbai, Prague, Paris, or Sydney
- Current UC Berkeley student (Expected Graduation Date of Summer 2019 or later)
- Have completed a 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act application, and are eligible for financial aid
- Have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$5,486 or less (Pell eligible students)
- Have not previously traveled outside of North America
- Have remaining financial need after all other eligible gift aid and scholarships have been calculated towards your program's cost of attendance
- Students who are awarded this scholarship are not eligible for the Berkeley Study Abroad Scholarship of \$1,500.

Recipients will be selected based on a combination of the following criteria:

- No prior travel experience outside of North America
- Excellence of academic record
- Applicability of chosen GI location to academic and career goals

Application Timeframe:

- Attach your scholarship application materials to this page before submitting your Global Internships application.
- Scholarship announcements will be made no later than Friday, March 15, 2019.
- Awardees must accept their scholarship by Friday, March 22, 2019.
- Per program policy, all applicants to Global Internships programs are charged a \$400 non-refundable program deposit on CalCentral. Not being selected for this scholarship **does not** qualify a student for a refund of the \$400 program deposit.

2. Application Essay (1-2 pages double spaced)

In one cohesive essay, please address the following:

1. Have you previously traveled outside of North America? What are the primary factors that have limited your opportunity to travel?
2. Why did you select this Global Internships location, and how specifically will the program help you meet your academic and career goals?
3. Please describe one or more activities that best highlight how you have taken initiative in your academic, work, or community environments during your undergraduate career.
